Fission Knitting

Fission Knitting is a reversible colorwork technique where the fabric is worked with yarns held in a marl. The design elements are slipped stitches placed on both sides of the fabric. The marl is broken apart to work these stitches. The resultant fabric has a marled middle layer and an overlaid design on each side. It is possible to create a different cabled design on each side of the fabric.

In this class we will be making a small swatch with Fission Knitting. You will learn the 3 rules of Fission Knitting, how to form the stitches, create cables, manage your yarn and read your knitting. Experience knitting cables is required. There is no homework and a materials list will be distributed before class.
