



## GBKG Virtual Workshop

**Proficiency Level:** Adventurous beginners. Must be comfortable with decreasing.

**Description:** Short rows are a very handy way to add shaping to your knitting in both conventional and unexpected ways. Use them to turn a heel on a sock, better tailor a garment to your shape, or add unexpected twists and turns to accessories. In this class, we'll discuss the mechanics of short rows, try out different short row techniques, and think about when and where to use them.

**Homework:** Students should cast on 24 stitches with smooth, light-colored worsted weight yarn and a US 7 [4.5 mm] circular needle and work about an inch in stockinette prior to class, ending ready to work a RS row. Do not bind off. Make sure to leave at least another 70yards [64 m] of yarn attached.

**Materials:** writing implement for taking notes
